## PETITIONER'S SUPPLEMENTAL MOTION FOR TIME TO FILE REPLY AND FOR TIME TO FILE MEMORANDUM OF LAW IN SUPPORT OF PETITION

Answer to the Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus and granting him ninety (90) days from the

date of filing that reply within which to file a Memorandum of Law in support of his Petition for

Writ of Habeas Corpus.
