PETITIONER'S MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL TIME TO FILE MEMORANDUM OF AUTHORITIES IN SUPPORT OF PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS

6. Petitioner states that this modest extension will not cause any undue delay in these

proceedings, and will not prejudice the Respondents.

7. Counsel for Petitioner have conferred with counsel Respondents, who stated that

they have no objection to the requested extension.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, Petitioner respectfully requests that the

Court enter an order granting him fourteen additional days, or until July 27, 2009, within which

to file a memorandum of authorities in support of his Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus.
