PETITIONER'S MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL TIME TO FILE REPLY TO RESPONDENTS' RESPONSE TO PETITIONER'S MERITS BRIEF

Petitioner, Jeffrey Havard, by and through his undersigned counsel, hereby moves the Court to enter an order granting him an additional thirty (30) days to file his reply to the Respondents' Response (Docket # 28) to his brief on the merits. 5. Due to the length of Respondents' Response brief, and the multitude of procedural and substantive matters raised therein, Petitioner's counsel will need additional time to review the Response, conduct legal research, draft the reply brief, and meet with Petitioner before filing the reply. Accordingly, Petitioner requests that the Court enter an order granting him an additional thirty (30) days within which to file the reply, which would be by January 13, 2010.

6. Petitioner states that this extension will not cause any undue delay in these proceedings, and will not prejudice the Respondents.

7. Counsel for Petitioner have conferred with counsel for the Respondents, who stated that they have no objection to the requested extension.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, Petitioner respectfully requests that the Court enter an order granting him thirty additional days, or until January 13, 2010, within which to file a reply to Respondents' Response to Petitioner's merits brief.
