
PORTABLE CHEST X-RAY 02/22/2002

Heart appears to be normal. Mediastinum is widened secondary to thymus and vascular structures, but otherwise unremarkable. Lung fields are clear. There is hyperlucency of the lung field possibly from overaeration of possibly asthma.

There is a nasogastric tube seen in the esophagus and in the stomach. There is marked dilatation of the stomach. There is a large amount of gas throughout the entire large and small bowel.

REPEAT CHEST X-RAY 02/22/2002

Lung fields are unchanged. There is now decompression of the stomach. Nasogastric tube is again seen in place. On this examination there appears to be an endotracheal tube present in the trachea. Tip of this tube is at the level of C6 cervical vertebra.
