ORDER FOR MEDICAL RECORDS

This cause came before the court this date on motion of the defense for production of medical records of the alleged victim, one Chloe Madison Britt, with a date of birth of August 29, 2001, and a date of death of February 21, 2002. The court finds that the motion is well taken.

It is therefore ordered that any medical privilege of the said alleged victim is waived by virtue of this court order and any and all medical records of said alleged victim are hereby ordered and directed to be released and provided to either counsel for the defendant, the Hon. Robert Clark or the Hon. Gus Sermos, or the Hon. Ronnie L. Harper, Adams County District Attorney, or any of his staff. Any costs incurred for any such records shall be borne by Adams County.

It is further ordered that copies of any such records, whether obtained by defense counsel, or the District Attorney's staff, shall be forthwith provided to the opposing side. It is further ordered that any such records shall not be disseminated by either the prosecution or defense to any parties not involved in this prosecution. Any records obtained pursuant to this order shall be subject to any and all objections by either side.


It is further ordered, to facilitate the prompt obtaining of such records, that the State shall make prompt inquiry of the victim's mother, no later than seven (7) days from date, of any and all medical providers that provided any medical services to the said alleged victim. With that information, the State may either obtain all of such records and provide copies to the defense, or

notify the defense of the names of all of such providers. In either event, it is the court's intention that the records be obtained as soon as possible, such as to not delay the presently scheduled trial on October 28, 2002, with copies being available to both the prosecution and the defense

It is further ordered that the circuit clerk forward a certified copy of this order to both defense counsel, and also to the District Attorney, and furnish any further or additional certified copies to either side as may be necessary or needed.
